And I discovered that to be true of Earl...He played the guitar gracefully and kind and that's how I found him to be as a person as well".

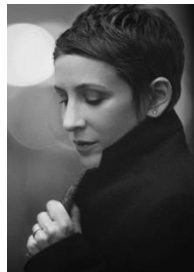

Stacey Kent

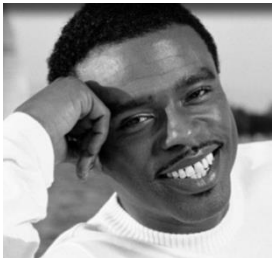
Saturday, December 9, 2017
